
### Sensible Safety First Rules

he Old Station Yard is a quiet, sheltered and secluded campsite close to the River Tay, ie hills and country paths.

### uitable For

ividual and group bookings such as canoeists, rafters, cyclists, hillwalkers, hikers, courts, outdoor pursuits, Duke of Edinburgh awards, touring caravanners, orienteers, anoe-campers, groups stopping off on the way north.

### acilities include

ar parking for 40 cars  
amping for around 50 tents  
pace for 6 touring caravans  
oilet (and shower for booked guests) – wheelchair access  
vent control room with sink – wheelchair access  
lens toilet and showers  
/omens toilets and showers  
ampers wash-up sinks  
hemical toilet disposal  
rey water disposal  
rinking water standpipe



The SCA provides a public toilet at this side door during the season as a community service.



The campsite is managed by the Riverside Inn on the opposite side of the main road.
